

Kalayaan town declared 'insurgency-free'

SANTA CRUZ, Laguna (PIA) – Once known as a guerrilla base of communist insurgents, Kalayaan town was declared insurgency-free on Monday, July 4 making it the first town in Laguna under the Stable Internal Peace and Security (SIPS) status.

The SIPS status was conferred in a program by an inter-agency body following the absence of recorded violent activities and organizations in Kalayaan. Brigadier General Cerilo Balaoro, Jr., 202nd IB commander, continued his call to the remaining members of the CPP-NPA to return to the folds of the law, join the mainstream society, and benefit from the government's reintegration program.

"Let us join hands and continue to support the government's initiatives to end the local communist armed conflict," Balaoro added. According to Capt. Warren Ching, Civil Military Officer of the Philippine Army's

202nd Infantry Brigade, Kalayaan once served as an access point and guerrilla base for the communist insurgents.

"Dito dati nahuhuli ang mga matataas na lider ng NPA. Daanan ang Kalayaan mula Northern Quezon papuntang Laguna or Southern Quezon, para siyang highway. Looban kasi siya, lalo na ang (barangay) San Antonio, na dating pinupuntahan ng mga NPA," Ching added.

Despite Kalayaan's SIPS status, the Army said that they will continue monitoring and operating through their patrol base in the area. Laguna province was declared under the SIPS status on September 2019, making it the second province in the country after Cavite to do so. However, the Army said that individual declaration of the status in each cities and municipalities would further help the Army's goals in securing peace and stability in the region.

"Maganda na ang Laguna ay SIPS status. Kailangan din kasi na every municipality ay mag-declare ng SIPS para ma-continue yung information operations natin sa AFP, para masabi natin na itong CTGs ay masabing hindi na welcome sa mga municipalities na SIPS-declared," Capt. Ching said.

He added: "Tinarget namin na lahat ng munisipyo sa Laguna, including cities, ay mailagay sa SIPS. Sa ngayon ay nagco-coordinate pa lang kami kasi hindi naman siya basta basta. May criteria pa kami para masabi na insurgency free or SIPS status na pino-promote namin." **(CH/PIA-Laguna)**

BATANGAS CITY (PIA) — Matagumpay na inilunsad ng Department of Health – Center for Health Development (DOH-CHD) Calabarzon ang TEENDIG Kabataan! Kalusugan ay Pahalagahan adolescent-friendly facility sa Batangas City Integrated High School nitong Miyerkules, Hulyo 5.

Ito na ang ikalawang pasilidad na inilunsad ng DOH-CHD at Department of

Education (DepEd) Region 4A sa rehiyon upang mapalakas pa ang kanilang kampanya ukol sa pagtataguyod ng sex education at mental health awareness sa mga kabataan.

Layon ng TEENDIG project na unang inilunsad sa Antipolo City National High School na magkaloob ng mga serbisyong pangkalusugan sa mga mag-aaral na makakatulong rin sa kanilang psychosocial at

mental well-being.

Ang TEENDIG project ay may kapasidad na magbigay ng iba't ibang serbisyo tulad ng general health assessment history, physical exam, healthy lifestyle counselling, substance abuse counselling, cancer prevention counselling, psychosocial risk assessment and management, at reproductive health assessment and counselling.

Ayon sa DOH-CHD 4A Regional Director Ariel I. Valencia, isa ang TEENDIG project sa nakikita nilang paraan upang tugunan ang

ilang isyung pangkalusugan na kinakaharap ng mga kabataan sa ngayon.

Batay sa datos ng DOH, tumaa sa 9.38% ang kaso ng teenage pregnancy noong 2022 kumpara sa 8.64% na naitala noong 2020 para sa mga kabataang edad 10 hanggang 19. Sa Calabarzon, aabot sa 4,261 kaso ng maagang pagbubuntis ang naitala kung saan nanguna ang Rizal 1,187 sinundan ng Batangas 935; Laguna 829; Cavite 758 at Quezon 552.

Nasa 1,454 naman ang naitalang bagong kaso ng HIV ngayong 2023 kung saan karamihan sa mga naitalang kaso ay may kaugnayan sa 'MSM o men who have sex with men.'

Ayon kay Valencia, gagamit ng peer-to-peer approach ang proyekto upang palakasin ang mga kabataan at gawin silang health advocates.

"In this project, we will adopt a peer-to-peer approach. We will

empower the students by engaging them to be the health advocates themselves. Bridging the gap to certain health issues that the youth are facing today," pahayag ni Valencia.

Kabilang sa mga nagbigay ng suporta at dumalo sa pglulunsad ng pasilidad sina Batangas 5th District Representative Mario Vittorio Mariño, Mayor Beverly Rose, Bb.
